In 2019, a young boy named Timmy was called to preach here at the camp. This year, he attended Teen Week 2 and preached in the preacher boy competition from the same Scripture that God used to convict his heart the night he surrendered. As encouraging as it is to see young people making decisions to serve God, it is even more encouraging to see them keeping those decisions.



During Ladies' Retreat, we saw one of the most creative segues into a Gospel presentation. A lady named Mrs. Landem invited a lady she had never met before to sit down and play a game of Scrabble. One of the words Mrs. Landem spelled out was the word "saved." She then asked her new friend if she was saved and found out she wasn't. From there, she was able to share the Gospel and lead her to the Lord.

Thank you so much for all of your prayers and support throughout this camp season. It's hard to believe that we are wrapping up another summer. We watched God work in the lives of many young people that attended camp this year. Through the Spirit-filled preaching and much prayer, we were able to see 1,575 decisions made, 15 souls saved, 6 surrender to preach, 5 surrender to missions, and 3 surrender to full-time ministry up until this point in our summer.
