One gentleman that started coming to church has been looking for answers about salvation and victory in Christ. He came forward after Shane preached asking for help. Shane has been sharing discipleship material with him, but his family who have a Reformed Theology background have discouraged him from going through any discipleship/counseling courses. We are praying he would be open to going through the Scriptures. t

A neighboring family recently came to our Family Service, and we're praying for continued inroads with the family.

Liskeard Baptist Church recently set up booths at two local events for outreach. One was the Liskeard Show and the other was the Lions Family Fun Day. Both events provided opportunities to hand out invites to the church and to our Holiday Bible Club.

We are in the middle of our Holiday Bible Clubs this week with Liskeard Baptist Church. This year they are being held in Bodmin and Liskeard. We're praying for fifty children between the two, for souls saved, and for kids and families to start attending through our outreach.

We have been spending quite a bit of time over the past couple months studying for our Driving Theory Test. Our prayers were answered; we passed our Driving Theory Test. We've also been taking weekly driving lessons in preparation for our Practical Driving Test, and combined we have had around 32 hours of driving lessons. The biggest hurdle for us has been learning roundabouts, when to use or not use our blinker (indicator), and what would be considered a serious violation. Our driving instructor has told us he believes we're ready to test. Praise the Lord! Please pray that Shane can get a test scheduled in August that will work with the instructor's schedule. Jericho has been able to get a test scheduled for August 16th.

Jericho and the baby have both been healthy in the recent scans. We have a due date of 1/10/25 and appreciate your prayers for mom and baby.

The kids are enjoying summer break right now. They're excited about the break, and so are we. During the break we have had a visit from our Pastor, Josh Carter and his family, and Jericho's mom is with us now. It's been a blessing to have family and friends here to see where we minister.

The last couple weeks of school we attended several annual school events. Each one was new to us, but gave us greater insight into British culture, as several parents expressed to us that they did the same thing when they were kids in the school. The school has been the best way so far for our family to make connections. After Rylee's teacher invited Shane to come in to sing Bible songs and give a Bible lesson, we have had an open door to go several times over the past couple months. Before summer break we were even asked to come in this Fall for a Harvest service and a Thanksgiving service. Because the school encourages parental involvement Shane has also asked the Head Teacher of the school about coming in to do cooking classes in the Fall. He liked the idea and asked if we would like to do a weekly club instead of one-off classes. Once we get our background checks completed, we will be able to begin. This will give us an inroad to meet more students, as well as have more interactions with families. Several parents, children, and teachers have already come to us expressing their gratitude for the song times and cooking class we did. All of these things are avenues to meeting people, making connections, and creating opportunities to share the Lord. Please pray for continued inroads.
