

The Chacon Family Sent from Northwest Bible Baptist Church



Dear supporting Churches,

Greetings, hope that you are all well. We had a wonderful revival meeting in Mexico this past month (July) in Mexico. I hosted a pastor's and workers conference in Guerrero, Mexico. The town is called "Tlapa". It is the municipality seat for this mountain region in the middle of nowhere. It takes five hours of driving through the winding mountain rounds to get there. A very uncomfortable and dangerous ride. Danger from cliffs as well as drug cartels who often ambush people suddenly to rob or kidnap people. I was with my wife (no children) for this trip. Over forty pastors from these villages attended the meeting. I sponsored this meeting (\$2,000) to feed and house the pastors for four days. God worked in a great way to encourage the pastors. I provided them with Soul Winning New Testaments. (see attached Video).

My Daughter Carla (age 20) is now engaged to be married with a young man from our church (Micheal Gonzalez). The wedding date will be on May 17th, 2025. My wife also spoke in a ladies meeting in Florida recently.

I preached in a Spanish neighborhood in a bus route area to about thirty people (outreach backyard Bible club) this month, several people were saved in Elgin,IL. Perhaps you are aware of the recent July 28th Venezuela elections. The Dictator lost the election by a landslide of votes from the opposition. He decided to proclaim himself the winner that night which provoked riots and violence. The military supports the Dictator and the political persecution has begun. This is one of my recent target countries with much outreach and pastor friends, partners on the ground. They are certainly going through many hardships (as well as dangers) There are no flights right now, no foreigners whatsoever allowed. If things do not change soon, another huge massive wave of asylum seeker immigrants is now preparing to make their way to the U.S border in even larger numbers than before. I know that our cities are overwhelmed already.



This is a humanitarian crisis for them and us as well. Them, because the journey and asylum process takes years and has many hardships especially for those who don't really qualify or are ineligible because of certain requirements. It is a crisis for us because it overwhelms our economy, social services, court system, just everything. With politics aside, it is filling up our Spanish churches in many places. I will be focusing on my migrant ministry in the Chicago area with all of this in mind during these next two months. The immigration court is deporting people every day. I know because sometimes I translate or interpret for some of them. Could it be that they can hear the gospel and get saved during their stay here? Since American missionaries cannot go there? Would you join me in leading the charge to reap the Harvest? The Bible says that Phillip the evangelist preached to the Eunuch and baptized him and saw him no more. Where will they go? The Lord knoweth them that are His. I will be hosting several evangelistic outreach meetings in the coming weeks in the migrant shelters in Chicago. The Venezuelan migrants are also in a spirit of hope and prayer anticipating what will happen in their country concerning their loved ones. I appreciate the missionary support, this allows us to have a personal budget for our family to be available, however, it does not finance the ministry, costs and expenses, overhead, and sometimes tracts, Bibles, john & romans, flyers, printing, food or meals occasionally for our outreach meetings, traveling, ect. These are always limited funds. If we have more resources, we can do more, example: I am seeking to host an outdoor rally in Chicago. Sometimes permits are required for public meetings in parks, a Chicago park permit alone costs \$400. I have 200 chairs and a P.A ready to go so we can move around the city preaching to these crowds with a utility trailer, but I need your help to do so. I am seeking to raise at least \$2,000 - \$3,000 needed soon. Thank you so much, I appreciate your support and prayers.
