Dear Supporting Churches:

Greetings, In my last prayer letter I spoke about my upcoming trip to Venezuela. Our visit to a city called Cabimas was interesting in several ways. We had a good evangelistic meeting, however, it didn't come without some challenges. First, a big stadium which was previously considered was denied for our use (permits denied). We had to downsize in order to comply with the requirements for a much smaller sports field. We started inviting people by passing out flyers. Our vehicles, the pastor's truck, was not starting. The other pastor who was involved also had a broken down truck just when we needed to go out with our workers and blitz the area. This hardship took place daily. Much time was wasted checking the vehicles, pushing the vehicles, waiting for the mechanic to come, etc. We then had generator failure during our street blitz which meant no P.A. system or loudspeakers. We did our best by walking to each place. Another hindrance was the radio station that we had hired to announce the meeting on the air was closed down and shut down by the authorities without cause (I have the radio manager's testimony on video). Remember that Venezuela is a communist country with a dictatorship. Our meeting had an attendance of 700 people and went very well. It was perhaps the best in orderly service, crowd control, logistics and planning. They do have freedom of religion and assembly but only when national pastors are leading the meetings. I still have yet to find an American missionary anywhere inside this country. Many people were saved, we saw over 500 people saved including other smaller meetings and our Sunday big days. I preached in three churches on that Sunday. Attendance was doubled and even tripled in some churches with our efforts. We also hosted a church conference for the churches and workers to prepare for our meetings. I recorded a video "inside Venezuela" that is attached. I encourage you to see it, the video is a glimpse of their everyday life. I saw people saved who were staying in the same hotel. We also did some street preaching and preaching on the buses (public transportation) in the city of Maracaibo. I returned to the states and have been visiting churches in New York.

I will be traveling to visit five churches in Pennsylvania this week and next week. My support level is about 70%. I continue to raise more support. Thank you so much for sending me to the Spanish Speaking world. I am planning and preparing my next project which will be targeting the unreached people groups known as Piarao, Yanomami and Wayuu. These indigenous tribal village ethnicities inside Venezuela do not have Bibles. They do have a new testament translation done by Wycliffe Bible translators many years ago. They were done by the missionaries of the previous generation who are no longer there. Their denomination also was forced to leave Venezuela during the social crisis years ago. These Bibles are in digital format only. I am now seeking to print them and put them in book form to send to these villages a copy of the Word of God for the first time. I may start the first printing with just gospel tracts, discipleship material, Sunday school childrens material, ect in their language. Would you consider helping me or adopting this project? Perhaps your church could sponsor giving the Word of God to one of these tribes. I will also be creating a digital gospel video in their native tongue to use for internet outreach in their regions and help announce the printed book form Bible. I have sought copyright permission from Wycliffe Bible translators and am waiting for a response. Please pray for this unique project. The Venezuela churches already have church members who speak those languages and can partner with us to reach their tribes.
