We were part of an exciting opportunity this month. We joined several church members to reach into the dark community of Flamingo and start a kids' club. We had 234 children, but many others were too afraid to join us this first time due to the continuous crime in the area. Although there are three huge churches in this community (none of them Baptist), none of them have attempted to reach the children in any way. The children there know absolutely nothing about God. They will be taught memory verses, Bible songs, the Wordless Book, and other truths for the very first time. One lady told our assistant pastor that she had been praying for someone to come and teach her children. She saw this club as an answer to her prayer! There are many houses surrounding the field where we meet, so children are not the only ones hearing God's Word. Please pray!

In our various comings and goings we meet many people. We know that God is in control of even these "chance" meetings. Let us share a few of them and ask that you pray with us about their salvations.

- Rogers—a man that Nathanael met while soulwinning. He seems open to the gospel.
- Two different missionary families—One is Mennonite and the other is Jehovah Witness. The Mennonite family is new to the country and is living in the town of Blankets, where we just started a new Bible Club.
- Gabriel—An American young man studying here. He expressed an interest in visiting our church.

The Gospel of Matthew translation has come to a close. We are working on getting a printer for John and Romans. Please pray

that we would be able to find one that will print these books for a reasonable price. The plan is to dedicate John and Romans in January.

On the family front, we had a great Thanksgiving with our co-workers the Mickeys, baked 160 cupcakes for our mission's conference, hosted missionary guests who were part of the conference, made a new friend who is visiting from Canada, endured the adventures of a teething baby, put up our Christmas decorations, and helped Linette's family schedule a visit (in May) ☺.
