Posoh (Hello in Menominee),

We would like for you to pray for a supporting church of ours in Ulen, Minnesota, that is just a few miles from the White Earth Indian Reservation. The Lord has given this pastor a burden to start a church on this reservation and has already provided them a building. They have been able to preach the gospel to these native people multiple times and have seen a good number of natives show up for the services. On Easter Sunday, my family and I had the privilege of being with this church in the morning then being part of the native service in the evening on the reservation. I was given the opportunity to preach a clear gospel message to the native people. Even though no one got saved, the whole evening you could see God working in the lives of these dear people from the time we picked them up to the time we dropped them off. The Lord is moving in White Earth! Please pray for the work that is happening on the White Earth Indian Reservation and that souls would be saved. The pastor is doing a great job with handling both ministries, but be praying that the Lord will call someone to take over the ministry to this reservation fulltime.

I received word recently that the VBS was approved for July 13-16 at the Neopit Park Pavilion and since it is an outreach to young people the tribe was willing to waive the fee for using the pavilion! We are really excited about this VBS opportunity and what the Lord is going to do through it! We have number of Navajo brothers and sisters that will be coming up to help. What a thrill to watch Natives reaching Natives with the gospel! We have also requested to use the pavilion ever Sunday morning from May through September, and though they cashed my check, I have not officially been told it has been approved. Once I get word it has been officially approved, we will be starting a Sunday morning service on May 22<sup>nd</sup> that will continue every Sunday through the end of September in the pavilion. We have already started passing out flyers on the reservation expecting that it has been approved. Pray we will have people show up on Sunday mornings and people will get saved!

Keep our family in prayer as we have been dealing with a variety of illnesses in the last few days. Pray everybody will get better quickly!
