Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

April has been another busy month here in the ministry. We started with a second coming of age event. This was not as well attended as the first but we were still able to see several boys trust Christ.

Then Nathanael was able to teach in the Bible college. There were about seventy pastors and lay leaders from numerous churches in Kenya. Class started Monday evening through Friday evening. Typically, class started about 7:30 AM and went to 9ish at night. They were some very good sessions. In addition to Nathanael teaching about eternal security, there was teaching about music, basic Christianity, and the Holy Spirit. Many people in Kenya doubt the security of their salvation. Much of African music is based on rhythm instruments and bodily movement as opposed to melody. Many Christians here in Kenya struggle with basic understanding of the Bible. And the doctrine of the Holy Spirit is much abused. These four classes dealt with these issues. Please pray as the students are back home, that they would relook at their notes and be able to internalize and use what they learned during this short but full week of learning.

Next, Kenyan schools resumed. Kenya is trying to get back on schedule after Covid-19 disrupting much their school year. Therefore, the new school year started the end of April. Please pray for us as we are teaching a new group of boarding school students.

Lastly, we had multiple holidays that disrupted our schedule. In Kenya, Good Friday is a national holiday as well as the Monday following Easter. Then, one of the former presidents of Kenya died and there was a holiday to remember him. In addition, one of the translators had both of his sons come down with malaria and have to spend time in the hospital. All of these add up to some disruptions for the translation project. However, God is good and we continue to make good progress. We are trying to finish translating the book of John by the beginning of July. Would you pray with us that we would be able to accomplish this.
