God continues to bless Liberty Baptist Church in Mexico City. In April, a couple trusted Christ as their Savior in the services; first David was saved, then, after two Sundays of bringing her out to church, Mezil also made a decision for the Lord. Both are getting disciplined. Danna, a girl in our Christian school, whose mom, Natalia, was saved and baptized a couple of years ago, trusted Christ in one of the Bible classes.

Sunday, April 30, was Kids' Day, (pictured below) and is always our biggest day of the year. This year the church had a record-breaking attendance of 447. 264 adults and teens squeezed into our auditorium with more than 80 adult visitors, 24 of whom made salvation decisions. Five children were also dealt with for salvation. God is so good! Please pray as we follow up on the visitors and especially those who made decisions.

The following Sunday, our church celebrated Mother's Day as the day always falls on May 10 and we always celebrate it the Sunday before the 10th. We had dozens of mothers who visited the church and five trusted Christ. Many saved the previous Sunday returned. The next Sunday was Family Day, and again an adult was saved that day. This coming Sunday will be Friend Day to finish the spring evangelistic campaign.

On June 1st, Rhonda, Kellie and I will be in Mexico City for our Christian school's high school graduation. Estefania, our graduate, was born a few months after we started our church eighteen years ago. Her father has been one of my right-hand men from the very beginning. Estefania has a great spirit and wants to serve God with plans to study in the Bible Institute. We are so proud of her. Last year's graduate, Sherlyn is studying in a Bible college in northern Mexico.

Our Bible Institute continued this semester as my daughter Kellie and I taught the students by video. While I taught Bible Doctrines, Pauline Epistles, Philosophy of Missions, and False Cults; Kellie taught Teaching Elementary Math to the ladies as well as Creation Science. Kellie has been very busy this year taking a Masters program in Education online as well as teaching at Fairhaven Christian Academy in our home church. Next year she will be supervising two of the ladies as they student-teach in our Christian school in Mexico City.

Our son, Jackson, graduated from Fairhaven Baptist College with a degree in Pastoral Theology and will be working as Youth Director and helping in the Spanish ministry as well as teaching in the Christian school at Westgate Baptist Church in Tigard, Oregon. He is getting married to Hannah Moodie, the daughter of Pastor Brent Moodie, a pastor in Mosinee, Wisconsin, on July 21st. Elias will continue his studies in Pastoral Theology in his junior year at Fairhaven and Joseph, our oldest son, is visiting churches raising support to return to Mexico as a helper in the ministry. It is a joy to see our children continuing to walk in truth.

Please pray as we leave our home church this week to travel coast-to-coast for the next ten weeks from the Baltimore-Washington, D.C. area on the Atlantic to the Seattle, Washington area on the Pacific. We will be in nineteen churches before returning in August to prepare for our return to Mexico City at the end of that month.
