19 visitors. Since then, we have had 9 different visitors come to Sunday morning services. Some have visited several times.

Just before Christmas, I received a call from the specialist that my cancer removal had been moved up to a couple days after the New Year. I really struggled with being anxious. I had to continually go through the process of casting my care on the Lord. I was very encouraged by all who prayed with me and for me. The experience was pretty hard to handle. I was awake for all of it. In the process, a second cancerous spot was found on my

nose. After the cancer had been removed, when the specialist began the actual plastic surgery, I realized how traumatic this next part would be. I gripped the table and prayed, "Lord, help me." The Persian specialist was very confident in his expertise. He said, "We don't need the Lord. We've got this!" I didn't have a chance to respond as he began to cut, sear, and sew. Please, pray for Dr. Nasseri's salvation. I sent him a letter to thank him for his great work, but I added an addendum bringing up his statement. In a second page, I wrote on considering the Creator and the wisdom of the wisemen in searching for Jesus.
